G O A L	Decrease the proportion of children not ready for school	By 2015, the proportion of children not ready for school will fall by 20%
	Increase opportunities for children and youth to be engaged outside of school hours	By 2015, 85% of children and youth living in priority neighbourhoods will complete school

## BELONGING TO COMMUNITY

G O A L	Increase opportunities for meaningful employment for people with disabilities	Increase the labour market participation for people with disabilities to 51%
	Decrease the unemployment and underemployment rates for immigrants and new Canadians	Increase employers participating in workplace inclusion initiatives that integrate immigrants and new Canadians into the workforce*
	Enable vulnerable seniors to remain living in their own homes and engaged in their community	By 2015, 93% of people over the age of 65 will be able to live in their own homes
	Increase the number of residents in priority neighbourhoods leading their own community development initiatives	By 2015, there will be an increase of 20% from the 2010 baseline of the physical and social assets in the identified priority neighbourhoods.
